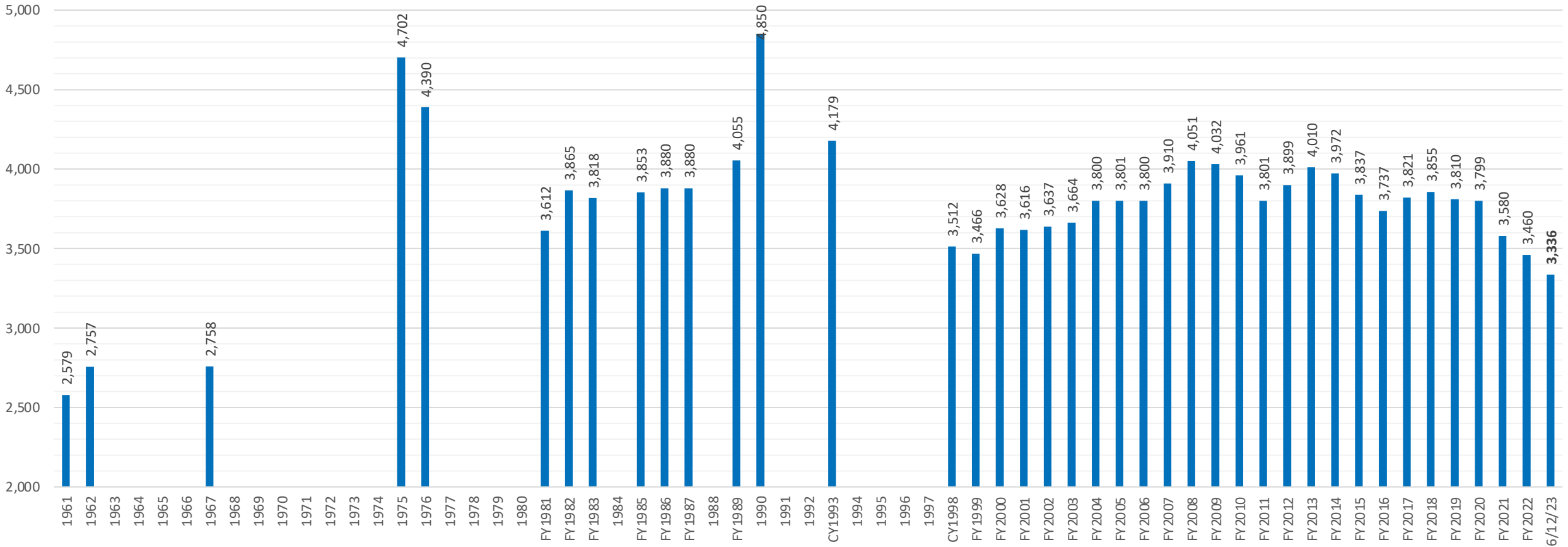

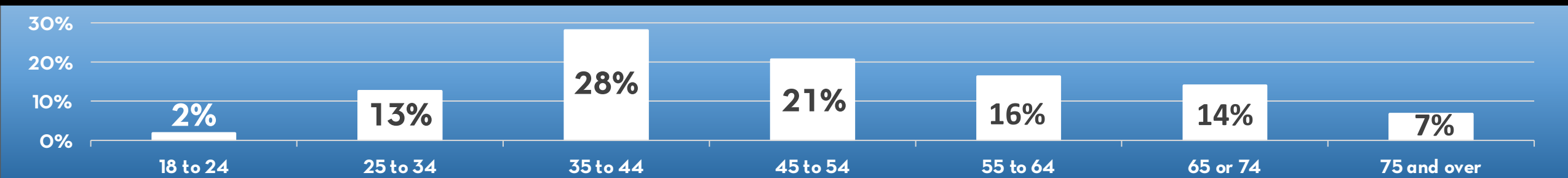

SURVEY RESPONDENT DEMOGRAPHICS

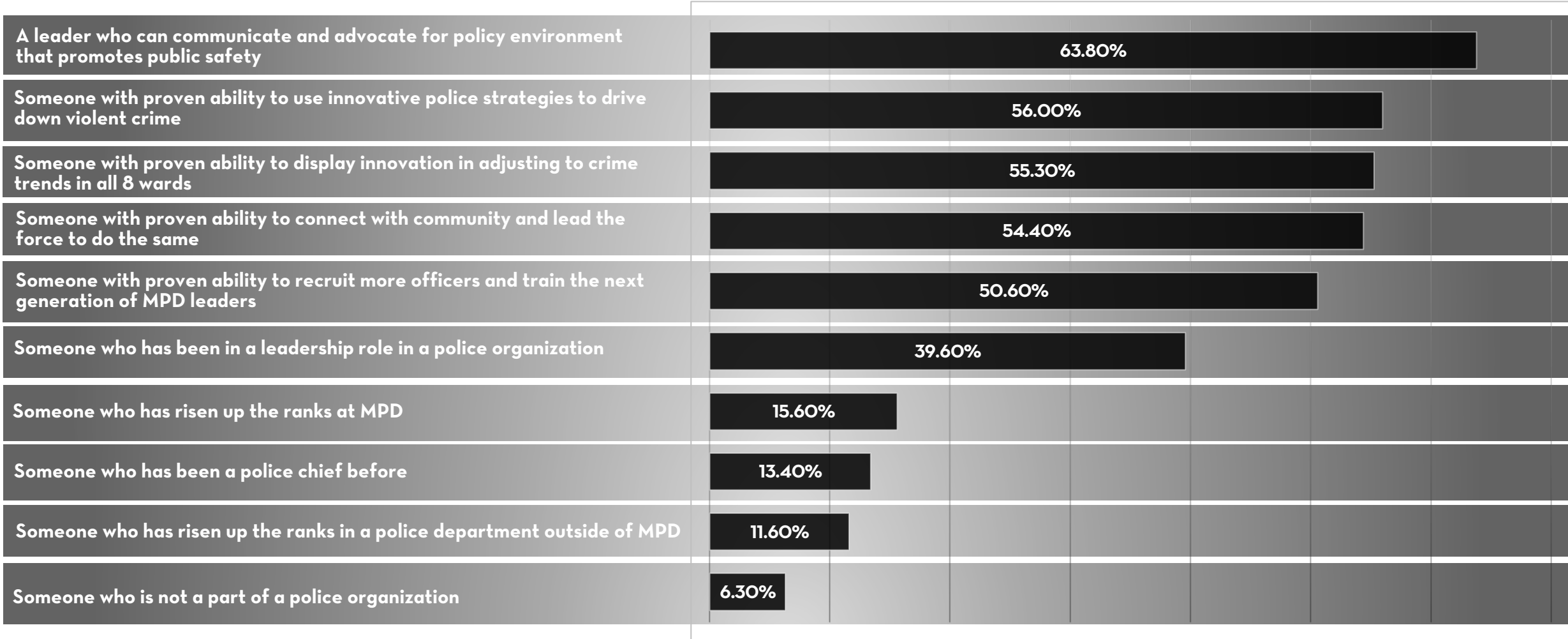

SAFER STRONGER 2.0

The Safer Stronger Amendment Act of 2023 is commonsense legislation to fill the public safety gaps:

- Increases penalties for illegal gun possession.
- Strengthens illegal gun laws by targeting the most pressing issues of ghost guns, Glock switches that convert handguns into automatic weapons, and illegal trafficking.
- Provides courts greater discretion for pre-trial detention of defendants.
- Makes strangulation a type of felony assault.
- Increases reimbursement for Private Security Camera program.
